

The attorneys will be responsible for organizing their teams and presenting the main arguments. The attorneys are the team leaders.

Legal researchers must provide their team with evidence from the text and outside sources.

Psychologists will research and present evidence pertaining to the psychological and emotional state of the client.

Ethicists will research and present evidence pertaining to the ethical issues of the case.

Experts will research and present evidence pertaining to medical and scientific issues of the case.

Witnesses will research and present evidence from the text. The witnesses will be Mr. DeLacey, Walton and some ghosts. Which ghosts will be determined after everyone applies for their jobs.

The Creature has sued Victor Frankenstein for emotional distress. The only way to get to the bottom of this situation is to have a trial. You are required to do all of the following:

1. Apply for a job using the online application. You must be thoughtful and thorough in your requests and responses. (5 points) due by December 6, 2010.
2. Prepare for the trial. You will have two class days to do library research. Any additional research must be done on your own time. You must collect evidence from the text and outside resources. You will hand in a team strategy sheet the day before the trial. Jurors will also be required to complete research. All of your notes and research will be due upon completion of the trial. (25 points)
3. Write a 4-5 paragraph, double-spaced, persuasive essay in which you thoroughly explain your argument. The essential question that you are answering is: "Who is ultimately responsible for the death and misery that takes place in Mary Shelley's novel?" This is not a group activity. Each person must write his or her own essay due the day after the trial. (40 points)
4. Write a one page, double-spaced reflection in which you discuss what you learned from the trial, the pre-trial planning and from the novel itself (10 points) due the day after the trial.
5. Participate enthusiastically in the Frankenstein Trial (20 points)
6. Present your written work in a nice neat folder and entitle it "Frankenfolio." (I happen to like Table of Contents and glitter). I will provide you with a copy of your job application page.
