
Your task is to do a brief analysis of the Romantic-era poem that you selected from the box. You must do all of the following:

- 1. Provide brief biographical information on your poet from Wikipedia.
- 2. Analyze a symbol from the poem.
- 3. Determine a Romantic ideal presented in the poem.
- 4. Discuss how that Romantic ideal might pertain to Mary Shelley's *Frankenstein*.
- 5. Create a visual of some aspect of your poem.

How to Cite Wikipedia:

"Mary Shelley." <u>Wikipedia</u>. November 2010. Wikimedia Foundation, Inc.. 22 November 2010. http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Mary_Shelley.

- 1. Name of article
- 2. Name of encyclopedia (in this case Wikipedia)
- 3. Date of last modification to page (look at the bottom of the entry)
- 4. Publisher (in this case Wikimedia Foundation, Inc.)
- 5. Date that you accessed the article.
- 6. Web address in slanted brackets.

I want to know what you think about symbols and connections, not what somebody on the InterWeb thinks. You will be graded just as much on effort and following directions as you will be on analysis. Extra credit will be awarded for extra-ordinary work! Good luck.
