- 2. What are the chief rhetorical strategies used in paragraph 27?
- 3. Why does King wait until paragraph 39 to address the alleged commendable behavior of the Birmingham police in "preventing violence"?
- 4. Trace the patterns of figurative language in King's letter: darkness and light, high and low, sickness and health
- 5. King uses repetition of single words or phrases, of sentence structures, and of sounds. Focusing on a passage of one or more paragraphs, discuss the effect of this use of repetition.
- 6. Considering the final three paragraphs as King's conclusion, discuss whether you believe it's rhetorically effective.
