After you have gathered, analyzed, and synthesized information, you will make a claim and back it up in the body of your research paper. A claim should clearly outline your argument.

Ex. Sherman Alexie's novel, *The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian*, suggests that the most serious problem facing Native Americans on the reservations today is poverty.
