## SOAPSTone

Remember that the elements of SOAPSTone often include more than just one answer. For instance, for "speaker," all of the following might be true: NY Times writer, human rights activist, American, parent, Iraq War veteran, and so on.

Speaker	The voice that tells the story. What role does the speaker play relative to the event?
Occasion	The time and the place of the piece; the context that prompted the writing.
Audience	The group of readers to whom this piece is directed
Purpose	The reason behind the text. Why was it written? What goal did the author have in mind?
$S_{ m ubject}$	What is the general topic, content, or idea contained in the text?
Tone	What is the attitude expressed by the speaker? Diction. Imagery. Speaker's attitude.
