

The author uses repetition and allusion to convince his readers to support Obama's Job Plan. In the final paragraph, the author repeats "we" at the beginning of three successive sentences in order to create a sense of community among disenfranchised American voters. Readers are not alone; they are a part of a bigger whole that together can change the current economic situation. Furthermore, by using "we," the author also puts himself into the same group with his audience thereby bolstering his own credibility. He is not some absent overlord; he is one of us and therefore we can trust him.
