



5 FORM POCKETS • Press page 3 down to page 4, applying pressure along the taped areas to adhere the pages. You now have two pockets between pages 3 and 4. Tape pages 1 and 2 together the same way.



6 INK THE TAGS • Apply ink to your tags by pressing the ink pad onto the tags (you don't always have to use rubber stamps to apply ink!). This just adds some interesting texture.



7 STAMP THE TAGS • Using the same or different colored ink, rubber stamp your tags. The defined pattern from a stamp contrasts nicely with the texture from the direct-to-paper technique you used in step 6. Decorate the tags however else you'd like.



8 INSERT THE TAGS INTO THE POCKETS • Place two tags in each pocket. You can tape or glue them into place or leave them loose for viewers to play with.
